Reminder of our Sports Days:

Years 1 & 2 will be held on THURSDAY 24th JUNE at 1.45 p.m.

Reception will be held on TUESDAY 22nd JUNE at 1.45 p.m.

Nursery is on FRIDAY 18th JUNE at 10.30 a.m. and 2.20 p.m.

Hopefully the weather will be kind and all our sports days will go ahead. Each child should bring 2 small cartons of drink/water clearly labelled with their name and should come to school in appropriate clothes on the day of their sports (T-shirt, shorts/joggers, trainers, sun hat). Don't forget the sunscreen if it is hot. Parents are invited to join the fun. On Tuesday and Thursday the **Wellington Road entrance** will open between 1.30 p.m. and 1.45 p.m. After that parents will need to gain entry by pressing the buzzer.

On Friday 18th June (Nursery Sports) the gate will be opened at 10.30 a.m. for a 10.45 a.m. start and at 2.10 p.m. for a 2.20 p.m. start. Parents are asked to go on to the field behind classes 13 & 14. The children will return to the Nursery at the end of their sports for a drink and will be dismissed from there.

Please bring something to sit on. Younger siblings are very welcome, but please make sure that they do not move or play with the equipment. At the end of the sports, please stay on the field until all the classes have gone back into school. The


teachers cannot get a clear enough view of their children if everyone is moving at the same time - we do not want to lose anyone!

Children will be dismissed from their classes as soon as their teacher is ready.

If Sports Days have to be cancelled because it has been raining (making the grass too slippery for the children) or it is raining on the day, notices will be posted on the noticeboards. We will inform you of alternative arrangements if we are able to make them. We look forward to seeing you.
