Enfield Libraries: Are running a "Summer Reading Challenge" again this year. This is a good way to keep your child reading regularly over the summer. The challenge is to read six books this summer. You have from Monday 5th July to Sunday 12th September to do this.

It is for children aged 4 (if at school) to age 12.

Children who are a member of the library in Enfield. Do not worry if you are not - it is easy to join and is FREE.

To take part you need to register. This is very easy and the staff will help you complete the registration form which is very quick to do. You will then be given a folder. You need to keep the folder and bring it with you when returning books you have read.

There are prizes for children who take part. You will get a sticker to put in the folder for each book read and -

- For reading 1 book - Blue "animated" card.
- For reading 3 books - A glow-in-the-dark wristband OR a glow-in-the-dark Space Hop Spinner - like a mobile of the planets.
- For reading 6 books - Medal and Certificate, plus raffle ticket for entry into Prize Draw to win family tickets to visit the London Planetarium. Our nearest library is
